To achieve these goals, where applicable Clearwater Paper Corporation implements the Sustainable Forestry Initiative® (SFI) Standard (2010-2014) and the Chain of Custody Standard; the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) Chain of Custody and controlled wood standards, and the Program for the Endorsement of Forest Certification Schemes (PEFC) standard.

Clearwater Paper Corporation's Policy is to implement and achieve the Principles of Sustainable Forest Management including employing environmentally, socially, and economically sustainable practices to meet present needs without compromising future generations. This is accomplished by practicing and promoting a resource and conservation stewardship ethic.

Clearwater Paper Corporation's Sustainability Policy is to promote the principles of sustainable development, recycling, and biodegradability. The Company has set an overall goal to increase recycled content in its products where technically and economically feasible and reclaim all waste material from its production processes to further reduce the amount of wastepaper entering the waste stream.

Clearwater Paper Corporation strives to increase the degradability of its products to ensure non-recycled components are recoverable, biodegradable, and/or compostable.

To help implement and achieve the above sustainability, recycling, and biodegradable objectives, Clearwater Paper Corporation has developed and adopted appropriate programs and documented procedures to guide its paper procurement, production of products, and associated environmental claims and labels.

Clearwater Paper Corporation is committed to annually review the effectiveness of its policy and programs as part of management review to continually improve the management system and environmental performance.
